A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI  
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE -  
SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,  
DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY  
(UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS)  
FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA)  
ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG) PROGRAM – OPERATIONS  
AND SAFETY PROGRAM)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grant Revenue - Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2017, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Fire and Public Safety, by increasing the appropriation for the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program – Operations and Safety Program by \$252,050, to read as follows:


