May I please request your response to the following:


1. In Section 3.9.2, Table 3-19 depicts County new development by community plan area. Within the Makawao-Pukalani-Kula and Pā'ia-Ha'ikū Community Plan Areas, the new development counts are 624 and 358, respectively.
 - a. Please identify the source the data was derived from.
 - b. How were new development counts quantified?
2. In Section 16.2.2, Table 16-9 refers to buildings in the wildfire risk hazard areas by occupancy class. Within the Pā'ia-Ha'ikū Community Plan Area, 3,156 residential structures are classified as low risk hazard, while 649 residential structures are classified as moderate risk.
 - a. How were these structures classified?
 - b. What factors were used to determine which structures belong in the Low or Moderate Wildfire Risk Hazard Areas?
