Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Bill 58 (2025), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE COSTS, REIMBURSEMENT TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR PROJECTS DISQUALIFIED FROM TAX-EXEMPT BOND ISSUANCE." Bill 58's purpose is to amend the 1) amending Section 2, Estimated Fiscal Year 2025 Budget by: Revenues, by increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund by \$5,790,476; 2) amending Section 3.B.6.g, Department of Finance, new Countywide Costs. by adding а appropriation entitled "Reimbursement to the General Fund for Projects Disqualified from Tax-Exempt Bond Issuance" in the amount of \$5,790,476; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.
 - 2. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2025, dated April 25, 2025, for \$5,790,476 in Carryover/Savings from the General Fund.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 58 (2025) on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of Bill 58 (2025) and other related action.

BILL 18 (2025), ESTABLISHING SECTION 2.56.080, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH PAY SCALES FOR THE BOARD OF ETHICS (BFED-25)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Bill 18, CD1 (2025), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SECTION 2.56.080, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH PAY SCALES FOR THE BOARD OF ETHICS." Bill 18, CD1's purpose is to amend Chapter 2.56, Maui County Code, by creating a new Section 2.56.080 to establish pay scales for the Board of Ethics staff. Bill 18, CD1 was recommitted to the Budget, Finance, and Economic Development Committee with Committee Report 25-25.
 - 2. An Amendment Summary Form, dated May 7, 2025, from Council Chair Lee, with a proposed CD2 version of Bill 18. The proposed CD2 version:
 - a. Clarifies that the bill applies to Board of Ethics staff and not the board members;
 - b. Clarifies that the salary for the Executive Director is within a range as opposed to set by a scale with steps;
 - c. Makes the Executive Director's maximum salary consistent with the salary set by the Salary Commission for the First Deputy Corporation Counsel;
 - d. Removes reference to the positions by which the salary scales were set to avoid conflicts when salary adjustments are made for those positions; and
 - e. Incorporates nonsubstantive revisions.

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

DEPARTMENT OF WAILUKU-KAHULUI GOVERNMENT COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, FACILITIES. Bill 63's purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget by: 1) amending Section 2, Estimated Revenues, by increasing the Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$3,250,000; 2) amending Section 4.C.3.a., Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, by adding a new appropriation for Bond Fund entitled "Acquisition of 105 North Market Street Building and Property" in the amount of \$3,250,000; 3) adjusting the totals accordingly, and 4) amending Appendix C - Capital Improvement Projects, Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, by adding a new project and project description entitled "Acquisition of 105 North Market Street Building and Property" in the amount of \$3,250,000.
- 2. Bill 64 (2025), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5659, BILL NO. 62, CD 1 (2024), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT)." Bill 64's purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding an appropriation for the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Other Projects, entitled "Acquisition of 105 North Market Street Building and Property" in the amount of \$3,250,000.
- Resolution 25-107, entitled "AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY CONSISTING OF 4,163 SQUARE FEET IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEY NO. (2) 3-4-017:027 SITUATED AT WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,200,000.00." Resolution 25-107's purpose is to authorize the acquisition of 4,163 square feet located at 105 North Market Street for \$3,200,000 plus expenses.

PROPERTY ACQUISITION IN WEST MAUI (BFED-20(8))

- **Description:** Under Rule 7(B) of the Rules of the Council, the Committee intends to discuss matters relating to property acquisition in West Maui, including Bill 69 (2025) to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget to transfer \$100,000 from the Office of the Mayor for due diligence on properties in Ma alea to the Department of Management for assistance with property acquisition in West Maui. Bill 69 (2025) has passed first reading and remains with the Council for consideration of passage on second and final reading.
 - <u>Status:</u> The Committee may discuss property acquisition in West Maui and other related matters. No legislative action will be taken.
