East Maui Emergency Funds for COVID 19

Matching funds to purchase a van for the Hana Sr. Center – Food delivery and kupuna care (normally funds would be raised through fundraising events – no events! All cancelled. (\$7,000)

HFUU – Hana Chapter – Funds for gift certificates to purchase locally grown produce (\$20,000)

4 mobile trailers for homeless shelters

Bags for food distribution

Testing kits & PPE, Masks, Gloves, Sanitizer

Plexiglass for public stores & services

100 Laptops for students

Containers (8 x 20) for emergency supplies in remote area of the East Maui District – Kaupo, Kipahulu, Hamoa, Maka'alaie, Nahiku, Keanae

Enforcement of STRH & B&Bs / Possible rental expenses to quarantine positive cases

6 Defibrillators for outlying areas

Mental Health services – Suicide prevention, domestic abuse, alcohol and drug abuse counseling

Abandon/junk vehicle removal – Vehicles are parked along the roads and sidewalks blocking line of site. More people are walking and riding bikes, etc.

Bike/Walking path – Hana Health to Pa'ani Mai Park (Land and clearing donated by Hana Ranch)

National Guard/Police – Funding for continued monitoring of Hana Highway Rd. closure

Rental assistance program/funding for displaced families

Commercial Community Kitchen for East Maui – we have an existing kitchen at the Hana Community Center we have been discussing for years! Septic System already upgraded. Need facility and equipment upgrades. Did apply for CDBG funds previously. Estimate about \$250,000.
