AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 9-10(2) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), provides that, upon written request of the Mayor, part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance may be transferred within a department by resolution or from one department to another by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, as amended, ("Fiscal Year 2018 Budget"), states that, unless otherwise provided, appropriations for each program may be disbursed for the following categories of use: (a) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay, (b) operations or services, and (c) equipment; provided the disbursement is within the program and category of use for which it was appropriated; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.B.4.f.(8) of the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, relating to the Department of Police, sets forth appropriations for the Investigative Services Program, the Technical and Support Services Program, and the Uniformed Patrol Services Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter, Mayor Alan M.

Arakawa has submitted a written request to transfer an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$150,000 from the Technical and Support Services

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Program, Category A (Salaries), to the Investigative Services Program, Category B (Operations), \$400,000 from the Technical and Support Services Program, Category A (Salaries), to the Technical and Support Services Program, Category B (Operations), \$21,000 from the Investigative Services Program, Category A (Salaries), to the Uniformed Patrol Services Program, Category C (Equipment), in order to disburse \$571,000 for operations, and equipment from the appropriate category; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter and Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions, and in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, it does hereby authorize the transfer of an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$150,000 from the Technical and Support Services Program, Category A (Salaries), to the Investigative Services Program, Category B (Operations), \$400,000 from the Technical and Support Services Program, Category A (Salaries), to the Technical and Support Services Program, Category B (Operations), \$21,000 from the Investigative Services Program, Category A (Salaries), to the Uniformed Patrol Services Program, Category C (Equipment) in order to disburse \$571,000 for operations, and equipment; and

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2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor,
Director of Finance, and Budget Director, and the Chief of Police.
