BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:


SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5657, Bill No. 60, CD1, FD2 (2024), "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget", Section 3.B.12.a.(2), Office of the Mayor, Administration Program, One-Year Commemoration of the August 2023 Maui Wildfires is amended to specifically name a fiscal sponsor and grantee, to read as follows:


