A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.32.050,
MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO MEETINGS
OF THE COMMISSION ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:


SECTION 1. Section 2.32.050, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

“2.32.050 Meetings. The commission shall meet at least [monthly.] bi-monthly (every two months).”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
