HĀLAU OF 'ŌIWI ART'S QUARTERLY REPORTS (BFED-32(11))

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BILL 150 (2002), ESTABLISHING A PARKING REVENUE **FUND** (BFED-119)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of Bill 150 (2022), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3. MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PARKING REVENUE FUND." 150's purpose is to amend Title 3, Maui County Code, to establish a parking revenue fund to provide funding for the County's parking operations, including maintenance, repair, security, safety, improvement, equipment, beautification, expansion, staff compensation, parking facility bond payments, and other related costs.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 150 (2022) on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of Bill 150 (2022) and other related action.

Bill 150 (2022)

AMENDMENTS TO PROMOTE EQUITY IN REAL PROPERTY TAX LEGISLATION. INCLUDING SECTIONS 3.48.361 AND 3.48.466, MAUI COUNTY CODE (BFED-32(10))

Description: In accordance with Rule 7(B) of the Rules of the Council, the Committee may discuss matters related to amendments to promote equity in Real Property Tax legislation, including Maui County Code Section 3.48.361, real property dedicated as 'āina kūpuna, and Section 3.48.466, long-term rentals.

<u>Status:</u> The Committee may discuss the matter. No legislative action will be taken.
