REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR PROPERTIES IMPACTED BY NATURAL DISASTERS OR WILDFIRES (BFED-35)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Bill 91 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON A REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR PROPERTIES DESTROYED OR DAMAGED BY NATURAL DISASTERS." Bill 91's purpose is to amend Chapter 3.48, Maui County Code, to conditionally exempt properties destroyed or damaged by natural disasters on or after August 8, 2023, from real property taxation for one year beginning July 1, 2024.
- 2. Bill 95 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE AUGUST 2023 FIRES DISASTER EXEMPTION." Bill 95's purpose is to amend Chapter 3.48, Maui County Code, to exempt from real property taxation from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025, residential real property within the Lāhaina tax map zone, known as zone four, sections five and six, and other residential real property following the submission to the Director of Finance of a copy of an insurance claim submitted to the insured's insurance carrier for damages sustained from the August 2023 Maui wildfires rendering

the property uninhabitable; to exempt real property classified as commercialized residential, TVR-STRH, and hotel and resort that house people displaced by the wildfires from real property taxation, based on the amount of months people are housed, from August 1, 2023, through July 1, 2025; and to allow taxpayers with a home exemption for property damaged or destroyed by the wildfires to maintain their exemption through June 30, 2025.

- 3. Bill 102 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO **ESTABLISH** AN AUGUST 2023 MAUI WILDFIRES EXEMPTION FROM REAL PROPERTY TAXATION." Bill 102's purpose is to provide real property tax relief for those whose property was destroyed or damaged in the August 2023 Maui wildfires.
- 4. Correspondence from Committee Chair Yuki Lei K. Sugimura, dated October 25, 2023, transmitting a proposed CD1 version of Bill 102 entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE (2023).AMENDING CHAPTER MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO 3.48. AN MAUI WILDFIRES EXEMPTION AUGUST 2023 FROM REAL PROPERTY TAXATION." The proposed CD1 version incorporates nonsubstantive revisions and is approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel.

RESOLUTION THE OF 23-218, AUTHORIZING TRANSFER AN APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN UNENCUMBERED THE DEPARTMENT FISCAL YEAR **2024 BUDGET** OF PLANNING, (BFED-39)

Description: The Committee receipt of Resolution 23-218. entitled is in **"AUTHORIZING** THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING. FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET." Resolution 23-218's purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget within the Department of Planning by transferring \$13,397 from the Administration and Planning Program General, Category В (Operations & -Equipment), to the Administration and Planning Program - Dune and Shoreline Management, Category B (Operations & Equipment), to cover a projected \$13,397 shortfall in the amount needed for the Coastal Dune Restoration and Management Coordinator.

- Description: The Committee is in receipt of Bill 96 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM. WAILUKU AND WEST MAUI ENVIRONMENTAL, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS." Bill 96's purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget by amending Section 3.B.10.c.(2).(iv), Office of the Mayor, Development Program, Wailuku Economic Development, Economic Environmental, and Cultural Programs; and Section 3.B.10.c.(2).(xxix), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, West Maui Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs; to update the fiscal sponsor for Retree Hawai'i from "Lokahi Pacific" to "Na Koa Manu Conservation."

BILL 100 (2023), AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET: APPENDIX A, PART I, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT (BFED-44)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of Bill 100 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, APPENDIX A, PART I, DEPARTMENT OF Bill 100's purpose is to amend Appendix A, Part I, MANAGEMENT." Grants and Restricted Use Revenues - Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2024, for the Department of Management, by adding a new grant entitled "Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance -Discretionary Community Project Funding/Byrne Byrne Discretionary Grant Program" in the amount of \$180,000. The proposed grant would be used to expand the channel capacity of the Public Safety Radio System in two locations, the Hyatt Regency Maui rooftop site and the

Kāʿanapali Beach Club rooftop site, to service the West Maui areas of Lāhaina, Kāʿanapali, Honokowai, and Kahana.
