BILL 35 (2023), RELATING TO QUARTERLY REPORTS ON THE **ACQUISITION AND DISPOSITION OF REAL PROPERTY (WAI-4)**

Description: The Committee is in receipt of Bill 35 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO QUARTERLY REPORTS ON THE ACQUISITION AND DISPOSITION OF REAL PROPERTY."
