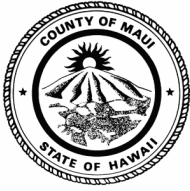

### **BILL 4 (2024), AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET: APPENDIX A, PART II, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND (BFED-66)**

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of Bill 4 (2024), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, APPENDIX A, PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND." Bill 4's purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget, Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues - Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2024, by inserting new conditional language under the Affordable Housing Fund to read as follows: "Up to \$4,929,088 must be for a grant to Aina Lani Pacific, LLC for on-site infrastructure for the Kilohana Makai project at TMK (2) 3-9-004:141, Kihei, Maui, Hawai'i."

**DISCUSSION OF BILL 11 (2024), AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2024**

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**BUDGET: OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (SPORTS AND EVENTS PROMOTION; TECHNOLOGY IN BUSINESS PROMOTION; GRANT TO HONE HEKE CORPORATION) (BFED-21(15))**

**Description:** Under Rule 7(B) of the Rules of the Council, the Committee intends to discuss matters relating to the proposed \$500,000 grant from the Office of Economic Development to Hone Heke Corporation included in Bill 11 (2024). The Committee may also discuss other matters relating to Bill 11. Bill 11 passed first reading at the Council's meeting of January 26, 2024, and remains with the Council for consideration of passage on second and final reading.

## **BILL 136 (2023), AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET: OFFICE OF THE MAYOR (ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM); AND EAST MAUI WATER AUTHORITY (BFED-63)**

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of Bill 136 (2023), entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM; AND EAST MAUI WATER AUTHORITY.” Bill 136’s purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget by 1) amending Section 3.B.10.a.(1) by reducing Category A - Salaries and Total appropriations by \$223,290; and 2) amending Section 3.B by adding a new appropriation for the East Maui Water Authority, Administration Program, with a Category A (Salaries) appropriation of \$223,290 and a Total appropriation of \$223,290.

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**BILL 8 (2024), AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET: OFFICE OF THE MAYOR (ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM) (BFED-72)**

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of Bill 8 (2024), entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM.” Bill 8’s purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget by amending Section 3.B.10.a, Office of the Mayor, Administration Program by 1) deleting under (4). Environmental Protection the conditional language for up to \$600,000 to be used for watershed management planning and implementation by Maui Environmental Consulting, Inc. (MEC) or Central Maui Soil and Water Conservation District and renumbering the subsequent conditions accordingly; 2) deleting the \$200,000 appropriation for Ho‘ahu Energy Co-op Molokai and renumbering the subsequent appropriations accordingly; and 3) adding a new appropriation entitled “Maui Family Young Men’s Christian Association” in the amount of \$200,000.

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of Bill 6 (2024), entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, REGARDING THE HAWAII BROADBAND EQUITY, ACCESS, AND DEPLOYMENT (BEAD) PROGRAM INITIAL PLANNING FUNDS.” Bill 6’s purpose is to authorize the Mayor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the University of Hawaii to collaborate on the Hawaii Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program. The University of Hawaii will provide \$100,000 to the County for community outreach to better identify and understand the community’s technology priorities and needs.
