BILL 67 (2024) AND BILL 68 (2024), COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENT AND CHANGE IN ZONING (CONDITIONAL ZONING) FOR QUEEN KA'AHUMANU CENTER (KAHULUI) (HLU-28)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1.Bill 67 (2024), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE WAILUKU-KAHULUI THE COMMUNITY PLAN LAND USE DESIGNATION FROM HEAVY INDUSTRIAL ТΟ BUSINESS/COMMERCIAL FOR APPROXIMATELY 6.75 ACRES IN KAHULUI, MAUI, HAWAI'I IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEYS (2) 3-7-002:020 (POR.) AND (2) 3-7-002:027 (QUEEN **KA'AHUMANU** CENTER), AND TO AMEND THE TEXT OF THE WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN (2002), AS AMENDED." Bill 67's purpose is to change the Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan land use designation from Heavy Industrial to Business/Commercial for 6.842 acres located at Kahului, Maui, Hawai'i, tax map keys (2) 3-7-002:020 (por.) and (2) 3-7-002:027 Kaʻahumanu for the Queen Community Center Revitalization and Infill Project, for mixed-use development consisting of residential, retail, office, services, open space, and green space.
- 2. Bill 68 (2024), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE INDUSTRIAL ZONING FROM M-2 HEAVY DISTRICT TO B-3 CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CONDITIONAL ZONING) FOR APPROXIMATELY 33.8 ACRES IN KAHULUI. MAUI. HAWAI'I.

IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEYS (2) 3-7-002:020, (2) 3-7-002:021, (2) 3-7-002:023. (2) 3-7-002:025, AND (2) 3-7-002:027 (QUEEN KA'AHUMANU CENTER)." Bill 68's purpose is to change the zoning from M-2 Heavy Industrial District to B-3 Central Business District for approximately 33.8 acres in Kahului, Maui, Hawai'i, tax map keys (2) 3 -7-002:020, (2) 3-7-002:021, (2) 3-7-002:023, (2) 3-7-002:025, and (2) 3-7-002:027. for the Queen Ka'ahumanu Community Center Revitalization and Infill Project, for mixed-use development consisting of residential, retail, office, services, open space, and green space.

Correspondence dated May 28, 2024, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a CD1 version of Bill 67 (2024), ORDINANCE TO entitled "A BILL FOR AN CHANGE THE WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN LAND USE DESIGNATION FROM HEAVY INDUSTRIAL TO BUSINESS/COMMERCIAL FOR 6.842 ACRES IN KAHULUI, MAUI, HAWAI'I, IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEYS (2) 3-7-002:020 (POR.) AND (2) 3-7-002:027 (QUEEN KA'AHUMANU CENTER), AND TO AMEND THE TEXT OF THE WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN (2002), AS AMENDED"; and a CD1 version of Bill 68 (2024), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE ZONING FROM M-2 HEAVY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TO B-3 CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CONDITIONAL ZONING) FOR APPROXIMATELY 33.8 ACRES IN KAHULUI, MAUI, HAWAI'I, IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEYS (2) 3-7-002:020, (2) 3-7-002:021, (2) 3-7-002:023, (2) 3-7-002:025, AND (2) 3-7-002:027 (QUEEN KA'AHUMANU CENTER)." The CD1 versions of Bills 67 and 68 incorporate technical and nonsubstantive revisions.
- **Status:** The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the CD1 versions of Bills 67 (2024) and Bill 68 (2024), with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of Bills 67 and 68 and other related action.
