BILL 136 (2024), AMENDING TITLE 20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ESTABLISHING A CLIMATE ACTION AND RESILIENCY PLAN FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI (ESCS-8)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. Bill 136 (2024), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ESTABLISHING A CLIMATE ACTION AND RESILIENCY PLAN FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI." Bill 136's purpose is to establish a climate action and resiliency plan to guide County policy and actions to mitigate and adapt to climate-change effects, transition to 100 percent renewable energy, and achieve net-negative emissions.
2. Correspondence dated November 8, 2024, from the Committee Chair, transmitting County Communication 18-23, a Status Report of the Draft of the County of Maui's first Climate Action and Resiliency Plan with the inclusion of the executive summary translated in 'Ōlelo Hawai'i.
3. An Amendment Summary Form dated November 12, 2024, from the Committee Chair, with a proposed CD1 version of Bill 136 (2024).

Huliko'a: Ua loa'a mai nā mea ma lalo i ke Kōmike:

1. Ka Pila 136 (2024), kapa 'ia 'o "HE PILA NO KEKAHI KĀNĀWAI KŪLOKO, KA HO‘OLOLI ‘ANA I KA PO‘O KĀNĀWAI 20, KA PAPA KĀNĀWAI O KE KALANA O MAUI, KA HO‘OKUMU ‘ANA I KEKAHI MANA‘O HO‘OKELE NO KA HANA ANIAU A ME KA HO‘OMA‘A ‘ANA NO KE KALANA O MAUI." 2. Ka launa palapala, ma ka lā 8 i ka mahina o Nowemapa i ka makahiki 2024, mai ka Luna Ho‘omalu Kōmike, ka ho‘ouna 'ana iā Ka‘a‘ike Kalana 18-23, he Palapala Hō‘ike no ke Kāmua a ka Mana‘o Ho‘okele no Ka Hana Aniau a me Ka Ho‘oma‘a 'ana, a me ka hō‘ulu‘ulu mana'o i unuhi 'ia ma ka 'Ōlelo Hawai'i.
3. He Palapala Hō‘ulu‘ulu 'Ōlelo Ho‘ololi, ma ka lā 12 i ka mahina o Nowemapa i ka makahiki 2024, mai ka Luna Ho‘omalu Kōmike, a me kekahī pukana CD1 i hāpai 'ia no Bill 136 (2024).

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 136, CD1 (2024) on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider other related action.
