# AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET: DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (STATE E911 WIRELESS COMMISSION) (BF-97)

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-166, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS **DEPARTMENT** PROGRAMS. OF POLICE (STATE WIRELESS COMMISSION)."
