AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET: DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT (WAIKAPU BASEYARDS) (BF-95)

- **DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-167, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:
 - 1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, WAIKAPU BASEYARDS; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by: (1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$550,000; and (2) adding an appropriation of \$550,000 under the Department of Management, Wailuku Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, for the Waikapu Baseyards.
 - 2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (BOND FUND – WAIKAPU BASEYARDS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding \$550,000 under Public Improvements, Estimated Project Cost, Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, for the Waikapu Baseyards.
 - 3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WAIKAPU BASEYARDS." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding (1) an appropriation of \$550,000 under the

Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, for the Waikapu Baseyards; and (2) a description of the project.

AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET: DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (SPECIAL NEEDS ADVOCACY PROGRAM) (BF-103)

- **DESCRIPTION:**The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-197, from the Budget Director,
transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO
APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANT REVENUE SCHEDULE OF GRANTS BY DEPARTMENTS
AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (SPECIAL NEEDS
ADVOCACY PROGRAM)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of
the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by: (1) increasing the grant for the Department of the
Prosecuting Attorney, Special Needs Advocacy Program, by \$692,175; and (2) increasing
the Limited Term Appointment (LTA) equivalent personnel to 10.0. The Department is
in receipt of a supplemental award from the State Department of the Attorney General.STATUS:STATUS:

AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET: ANIMAL MANAGEMENT REVOLVING FUND (BF-101)

- **DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-182, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017, ANIMAL MANAGEMENT REVOLVING FUND." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, relating to the Animal Management Revolving Fund (Chapter 3.84, Maui County Code), by adding an appropriation for: (1) the Maui Humane Society for \$20,500; and (2) the Molokai Humane Society for \$30,500. The funds will be used to purchase equipment.
 - **STATUS:** The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 16-182 and other related action.

2016 WEST MAUI AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND ANNUAL PLAN (FISCAL YEAR 2017 (JULY 1, 2016 TO JUNE 30, 2017)) (BF-13(2))

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 16-125, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

- 1. The 2016 West Maui Affordable Housing Fund Annual Plan and proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2017 Budget as it pertains to the Affordable Housing Fund.
- 2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, NA HALE O MAUI KAHOMA PROJECT." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2017 Budget by adding a \$660,000 proviso to the Affordable Housing Fund for the Na Hale O Maui Kahoma Project in West Maui for the construction of 12 single family homes to be sold to families earning between 80 percent and 120 percent of the area median income.
- 3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES – SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, HABITAT FOR HUMANITY KAHOMA PROJECT." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2017 Budget by adding a \$1,500,000 proviso to the Affordable Housing Fund for the Habitat for Humanity Maui, Inc. Kahoma Project in West Maui for the acquisition of 10 lots and construction of 10 single family homes to be sold to families earning 80 percent and below area median income.
- **STATUS:** The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 16-125 and other related action.
