COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENT FOR 1488 SOUTH KIHEI ROAD (KIHEI) (PSLU-25)

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of the following:

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Kihei-Makena Community Plan and Land Use Map from Business/Commercial to Single-Family for approximately 43,390 square feet at 1488 South Kihei Road, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii, identified for real property tax purposes as tax map key (2) 3-9-010:077, to make the property's land use designations consistent.
