AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET: DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY (TRAINING PROGRAM) (EDB-21)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 19-18, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

- 1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, TRAINING PROGRAM; TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget by: 1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund by \$33,200; 2) amending Section 3.B.5.b., Department of Fire and Public Safety, Training Program, by increasing Category C (Equipment) and Total appropriations by \$33,200 to fund the purchase of 15 automated external defibrillators (AEDs) and accessories; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.
- 2. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2019, dated December 21, 2018, for \$33,200 in Carryover/Savings from the General Fund.
- <u>Status:</u> The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 19-18 and other

related action.

AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET: DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (COUNTYWIDE POLICE FACILITIES) (EDB-20)

- **Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 19-17, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:
 - 1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAULAS PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT IT OF POLICE. COUNTYWIDE. GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, COUNTYWIDE POLICE FACILITIES: CAPITAL TOTAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT **APPROPRIATIONS**; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENT** PROJECTS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget by 1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$80,000; 2) amending Section 4.F.1.a.(1), Department of Police, Countywide, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, by increasing the appropriation for Countywide Police Facilities by \$80,000; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly. The \$80,000 appropriation is to upgrade the air-conditioning system in the Department of Police's forensic facility.
 - 2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4858, BILL NO. 54 (2018), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF POLICE - COUNTYWIDE POLICE FACILITIES)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by increasing the appropriation under the Department of Police, Countywide, Government Facilities, Countywide Police Facilities, by \$80,000.
 - 3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAULAS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX С -CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENT** OF PROJECTS. DEPARTMENT POLICE. COUNTYWIDE, The purpose of the proposed COUNTYWIDE POLICE FACILITIES." bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, Department of Police, by increasing the appropriation for Countywide Police Facilities by \$80,000.

- **Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 18-444, from the Budaet Director. transmitting а proposed resolution entitled **"AUTHORIZING** THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget within the Department of Finance by transferring \$32,290 from Countywide Costs, Category B (Operations), to the Administration Program, Category A (Salaries), for the Internal Control Officer.

FISCAL YEAR AMENDMENTS TO THE **2019 BUDGET** TO AUTHORIZE TRANSFERS RELATING TO CATEGORIES USE OF WITHIN Α PROGRAM OR DEPARTMENT (DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS) (EDB-156(5))

- **Description:** The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated December 21, 2018, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled **"AUTHORIZING** THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget within the Department of Public Works by transferring \$100,000 from the Engineering Program -General Fund, Category A (Salaries) to Category B (Operations) to fund a projected budgetary shortfall because of higher than anticipated expenditures for utilities and repair and maintenance services under the County Building Services section.
