

WAILUKU CIVIC COMPLEX (EDB-76)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 17-335, from Councilmember Riki Hokama, relating to the design, construction, and funding for the Wailuku Civic Complex.
2. Correspondence dated March 25, 2019, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4858, BILL NO. 54 (2018), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE

AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT - WAILUKU CIVIC COMPLEX).” The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2019 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by decreasing the appropriation under the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Wailuku Civic Complex, by \$26,963,000.

Status: The Committee may receive a presentation from the Department of Finance relating to the financial status of the Wailuku Civic Complex project. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 17-335 and other related action.
