BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAULAS IT PERTAINS TO PART II. SPECIAL **PURPOSE REVENUES** SCHEDULE OF **FISCAL** REVOLVING/SPECIAL **FUNDS** FOR YEAR 2020. AFFORDABLE HOUSING **FUND** (HABITAT **FOR** HUMANITY. AFFORDABLE HANA HOUSING PROJECT)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues - Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget,

by adding a proviso under the Affordable Housing Fund for Habitat for Humanity for the Affordable Hana Housing Project in the amount of \$5,000,000. The project includes land acquisition and new construction of 25 affordable single-family homes, with an affordability period of 30 years.
