Description: The Committee is in receipt of a correspondence, dated September 12, 2019, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) GRANTS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget by increasing the grant appropriation for the Department of Police, Department of Health (DOH) Grants, by \$98,355, to cover increasing costs for salaries and premium pay.

Description: The Committee is in receipt of a correspondence dated November 3, 2019, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE (EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANTS)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget by increasing the grant appropriation for the Department of Police, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants, by \$94,847. The total grant funding of \$274,847 is to be used for 1) Cybercrime Unit Enhancement, \$63,980; 2) Update Drug Analysis Instrumentation, \$130,363; 3) Statewide Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force (SMDTF), \$44,304; and 4) Enhance Physical Evidence Detection, \$36,200.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of the correspondence and other related action.

Description: The Committee is in receipt of a correspondence dated September 26, 2019, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I, GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT (SHSG) PROGRAM)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, by increasing the grant appropriation for the Emergency Management Agency, State Homeland Security Grant (SHSG)

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Program, by \$204,000. The SHSG program provides funds to prevent, deter, respond to, and recover from threats and incidents of terrorism and supports the County of Maui in leveraging funding to support National Preparedness System initiatives.

AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET: AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND (HABITAT FOR HUMANITY, AFFORDABLE HANA HOUSING PROJECT) (EDB-52)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 19-368, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND (HABITAT FOR HUMANITY, AFFORDABLE HANA HOUSING PROJECT)." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues - Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, by adding a proviso under the Affordable Housing Fund for Habitat for Humanity for the Affordable Hana Housing Project in the amount of \$5,000,000. The project includes land acquisition and new construction of 25 affordable single-family homes, with an affordability period of 30 years.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 19-368 and other related action.
