<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated December 3, 2019, from Council Chair Kelly Takaya King, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE REVISED CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (1983), AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH THAT COUNCIL AND MAYORAL TERMS WILL START ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN DECEMBER FOLLOWING A GENERAL ELECTION." purpose of the proposed resolution is to place on the next General Election ballot the question of whether the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, should be amended, effective January 2, 2021, to change the Council and Mayoral terms to start on the first Monday in December following a general election.

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated September 27, 2019, from Council Chair Kelly Takaya King, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE REVISED CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (1983), AS AMENDED, TO REORGANIZE THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH TO ESTABLISH AN OFFICE OF THE MANAGING DIRECTOR AND **PROVIDE FOR** THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MANAGING DIRECTOR AS THE COUNTY'S CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to place on the next General Election ballot the question of whether the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, should be amended, effective January 2, 2021, to reorganize the executive branch for the County of Maui as follows:

- Establish an Office of the Managing Director, where a Managing Director-hired by the Council through a recruitment and selection process involving the Mayor, Council Chair, and a three-member citizen group-will function as the County's chief operating officer responsible for the County's daily operations, the appointment and removal of most department heads, and the implementation of County policy.
- Revise the Mayor's role to be the County's chief executive officer responsible supervising the Managing Director's work. representing the County in intergovernmental affairs, having the authority to approve or veto bills, nominating commission members, and enforcing provisions of the Charter, County ordinances, and all applicable laws.

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PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT (APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADS) (GET-10(1))

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Correspondence dated March 22, 2019, from Council Chair Kelly Takaya King, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE REVISED CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (1983), AS AMENDED, RELATING TO APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY ADMINSTRATIVE HEADS." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to place on the next General Election ballot the question of whether the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, should be amended, effective January 2, 2021, to clarify that any person appointed as an acting head of a department should not have been previously denied by the Council as the administrative head for the same department.
- 2. Correspondence dated December 31, 2019, from Council Vice-Chair Rawlins-Fernandez, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE REVISED CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (1983), AS AMENDED, RELATING TO APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to place on the next General Election ballot the question of whether the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, should be amended, effective January 2, 2021, to prohibit the Mayor from appointing a temporary appointee as an administrative head of a department if that person was previously denied appointment as a department head within the same Mayoral term.
