NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii, on Friday, May 15, 2020, beginning at 10:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, via BlueJeans link: https://primetime.bluejeans.com/a2m/live-event/gcqgczrs for the purpose of receiving testimony, pursuant to Section 249-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and Section 3.24.030, Maui County Code, regarding the Motor Vehicle Weight Tax rates for Fiscal Year 2021:

- 1. Effective January 1, 2021, \$0.035 per pound of net weight for passenger vehicles, and trucks and noncommercial vehicles not exceeding 6,500 pounds (no change).
- 2. Effective January 1, 2021, \$0.0536 per pound of net weight for all other motor vehicles (no change).
- 3. Minimum tax for any motor vehicle is \$12 (no change). Penalty for delinquent tax is \$8 for passenger vehicles (no change) or \$20 for other vehicles (no change).

"Board Packets", as defined in Section 92-7.5 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, are available for inspection at the Office of the County Clerk, between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., by appointment, on regular business days. "Board Packets" are also available electronically as soon as practicable upon request.

Individuals may provide oral testimony by phone or videoconference. Each testifier shall be allowed to speak for up to three minutes. If approved by the presiding officer and announced prior to any oral testimony being taken, the testifier may be allowed one minute to conclude their testimony. No further oral testimony by the testifier shall be permitted. An individual's request to testify may be deemed withdrawn if the individual does not answer when called to testify.
