LEGISLATION AND DISCUSSION ON THE EFFECT OF THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC, RULES, CARES ACT, AND RELATED ISSUES (EDB-85)

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 20-207, from Council Chair Alice L. Lee, transmitting the matter relating to legislation and discussion on the effects of the coronavirus pandemic and related issues under the Economic Development and Budget Committee's authority.
- County Communication 20-275, from the Mayor, relating to COVID-19 updates, rules, CARES Act, and other related matters, and transmitting a report entitled "COVID-19 EXPENDITURES AS OF APRIL 30, 2020," from the Budget Director.
- **Status:** The Committee may consider the funds already appropriated to assist with the response to the coronavirus pandemic, including possible additional funds from the State Legislature through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES") Act, and other related matters. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of County Communication 20-207, County Communication 20-275, and other related action.

## **CIRCUIT BREAKER TAX CREDIT (EDB-81)**

- **Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 20-261, from the Director of Finance, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.48.810, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE CIRCUIT BREAKER TAX CREDIT." The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the tax breaker credit by: 1) increasing the maximum amount of the credit to \$6,500; 2) increasing the qualifying household income to \$130,000; 3) increasing the amounts of the homeowner's gross building assessed values at which the credit is phased out based on 0% of eligible tax credit to 100% of eligible tax credit; and 4) clarifying the credit does not supersede the minimum tax due.
  - **Status:** The Committee may discuss the matter. The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of County Communication 20-261 and other related action.
