EFFECTS OF THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC AND RELATED ISSUES UNDER THE ENVIRONMENTAL, AGRICULTURAL, AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE'S AUTHORITY (EACP-45)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 20-211, from Council Chair Alice L. Lee, transmitting the matter relating to legislation and discussion on the effects of the coronavirus pandemic and related issues under the Environmental, Agricultural, and Cultural Preservation Committee's authority.

Status: The Committee may receive a presentation from the State Department of Transportation relating to the following:

1. The Department's efforts to prepare for the State's reopening of tourism.
2. The potential impacts of the temporary suspension of 'Ohana by Hawaiian Airlines' passenger flights and cargo services between Honolulu (HNL), Moloka'i (MKK), and Lāna'i (LNY), beginning November 1, 2020.

WATER FOR AGRICULTURE (EACP-17(9))

The Committee may also discuss related matters. No legislative action will be taken.
