CORONAVIRUS EFFECTS OF THE PANDEMIC AND RELATED ISSUES UNDER THE ENVIRONMENTAL, AGRICULTURAL, AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE'S AUTHORITY (EACP-45)

Lee, transmitting the matter relating to legislation and discussion on the effects of the coronavirus pandemic and related issues under the Environmental, Agricultural, and Cultural Preservation Committee's authority.

- <u>Status:</u> The Committee may receive a presentation from the State Department of Transportation relating to the following:
 - 1. The Department's efforts to prepare for the State's reopening of tourism.
 - The potential impacts of the temporary suspension of 'Ohana by Hawaiian Airlines' passenger flights and cargo services between Honolulu (HNL), Moloka'i (MKK), and Lāna'i (LNY), beginning November 1, 2020.
