AMENDING CHAPTER 2.56, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO BOARD OF ETHICS ADVISORY OPINIONS (GET-25)

- **Description:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 19-143, from Council Chair King, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.56, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO BOARD OF ETHICS ADVISORY OPINIONS." - **Description:** The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated September 25, 2020, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF THERESA ANN COX v. COUNTY OF MAUI, ET AL. HCRC NO. RE-M-1165; HUD NO. 09-18-2683-8." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize settlement of the claim. The claimant alleges retaliation and discrimination based on race, sex, and disability, while Ms. Cox was a resident at Hale Makana O' Waiale, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii, between the period January 23, 2017 to January 2, 2019.
