COMPREHENSIVE AFFORDABLE HOUSING PLAN: INCOME GROUP DISTRIBUTION FOR RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING UNITS (AH-14(5))

Description: The Committee is in receipt of correspondence dated November 9, 2021, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.96, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO INCOME GROUP DISTRIBUTION FOR RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING UNITS." The purpose of the proposed bill is to increase affordable housing for Maui County residents by adjusting the distribution of units required as residential workforce housing units for income groups as defined in Section 2.96.020, Maui County Code, briefly described as very low, low, below-moderate, and moderate income households earning up to 120 percent area median income.

Status: The Committee may receive presentations from Jeff Gilbreath, Executive Director, Hawaiian Community Assets; Lisa Grandinetti, Organizer, UNITE HERE Local 5; Khara Jabola-Carolus, Executive Director, State of Hawai'i Commission on the Status of Women; and Faith Sereno Rex, President, SMS Consulting, LLC. The Committee may consider whether to

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recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of the correspondence and other related action.
