SUNSCREEN (CARE-54)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 21-305, from Councilmember Tamara Paltin, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE SALE, USE, OR DISTRIBUTION OF SUNSCREEN CONTAINING OXYBENZONE AND OCTINOXATE." The purpose of the proposed bill is to preserve the health, safety, welfare, and scenic underwater and natural beauty of Maui County by regulating the sale, use, and distribution of sunscreen containing oxybenzone and octinoxate.

Status: The Committee may receive a presentation or remarks from Peter Landon, Natural Area Reserve System Specialist, Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawai'i; and discuss the impacts of certain active ingredients in sunscreen; impacts the proposed bill may have on Maui County; and other related matters.
