## SEWERLINE EASEMENT FOR THE KAIAULU O KŪKU'IA AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT (LAHAINA) (IT-51)

**<u>Description:</u>** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 21-155, from the Director of Environmental Management, transmitting resolution entitled "APPROVING THE GRANT OF Α SEWERLINE EASEMENT LOCATED AT KAPUNAKEA STREET, LAHAINA, TMK (2) 4-5-035:037, RELATED TO THE KAIAULU O KŪKUʻIA AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT."
