BREAK FREE FROM PLASTIC POLLUTION ACT (CARE-48)

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 21-223, from Council Chair Alice L. Lee, relating to the Break Free from Plastic Pollution Act.
- 2. Correspondence dated June 10, 2021, from Committee Chair Kelly transmitting proposed resolution King, а "REQUESTING THE STATE'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SUPPORT REDUCING THE PRODUCTION AND USE OF CERTAIN SINGLE-USE PLASTIC PRODUCTS." The purposes of the proposed resolution are to support the Break Free from Plastic Pollution Act, pending before the 117th Congress as Senate Bill 984 (2021) and House Bill 2238 (2021); and to urge the State's Congressional delegation to also support the Break Free from Plastic Pollution Act.

Status: The Committee may receive a presentation or remarks from Lauren Blickley, Hawai'i Regional Manager, Surfrider Foundation, relating to the Break Free from Plastic Pollution Act (2021), single-use plastics' negative impact on the natural environment, and the proposed resolution. Committee may also discuss related matters and consider whether to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution, with or without revisions, the filing of County Communication 21-223, and other related action.

PROHIBITING THE SALE **AND** RENTAL OF **DISPOSABLE BODYBOARDS (CARE-34)**

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 20-526, from Councilmember Tamara Paltin, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE AND RENTAL OF DISPOSABLE BODYBOARDS." The purposes of the proposed bill are to preserve the health, safety, welfare, and scenic natural beauty of the County of Maui by regulating the sale and renting of disposable bodyboards; and to encourage the use of environmentally preferred alternatives.

Status: The Committee may discuss matters relating to the current use of disposable body boards and the impacts the proposed bill may have on Maui County. The Committee may also hear from the Office of the Mayor and the Department of Environmental Management and consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions, the filing of County Communication 20-526, and other related action.

PLASTIC DISPOSABLE FOODWARE (CARE-29)

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 18-430, from Councilmember Elle Cochran, transmitting a proposed bill relating to restricting the use and sale of single-use plastic disposable foodware.
- 2. Correspondence dated June 23, 2021, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20.26, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RESTRICTING THE USE AND SALE OF FOAM COOLERS." The purposes of the proposed bill are to promote public health, reduce litter, and limit harmful materials from entering the environment by:
 - Updating the definition of plastic disposable foodware to include foam coolers:
 - 2. Regulating and limiting foam coolers; and
 - 3. Encouraging the use of non-polystyrene coolers.

Status: The Committee may discuss matters relating to the current use of foam coolers and impacts the proposed bill may have on Maui County. Committee may also hear from the Office of the Mayor and the Department of Environmental Management, and consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions, the filing of County Communication 18-430, and other related
