HOMELESS PROGRAMS AND RELATED MATTERS (AH-19)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 21-110, from Councilmember Gabe Johnson, relating to homeless programs and related matters. The growing trend of temporary managed encampments has proven to be an effective tool for addressing the immediate needs of unsheltered individuals, providing connections to community services, and facilitating the transition to more stable and permanent housing.

<u>Status:</u> The Committee may receive presentations on managed encampments from representatives of the Honolulu Police Department's Homeless Outreach and Navigation for Unsheltered Persons (HONU) Project; Peter Radu, Homeless Policy Director for the City of Oakland, California; and Jon DeCarmine, Executive Director of GRACE Marketplace, a one-stop homeless resource center serving Alachua County, Florida. No legislative action will be taken.

COUNTY-OWNED PARCEL ON NORTH PAPA AVENUE (FORMER **COLLEGE DORM SITE) (KAHULUI) (AH-8)**

Description:

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The Committee is in receipt of County Communication 17-213, from Councilmember Stacy Crivello, relating to the County-owned parcel in Kahului, Maui, Hawaii, identified for real property tax purposes as Tax Map Key (2) 3-8-007-117. The parcel was formerly a University of Hawai'i Maui College dorm site and is located at Wahinepio Avenue and Kaahumanu Avenue. By Ordinance 4983 (2019), effective June 7, 2019, the Council authorized a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with the State for the construction of emergency housing at the site. By Ordinance 5005 (2019), effective November 8, 2019, the Council authorized an MOU to receive \$864,200 from the State for Phase 1 of the 'Ohana Zone - Kahului Affordable Housing for Homeless Families project.

Status:

The Committee may receive a status update on the project from the Department of Housing and Human Concerns and may discuss the matter. No legislative action will be taken.
