### SHORT-TERM RENTAL HOME PERMIT CAPS (PSLU-67)

**<u>Description:</u>** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication 21-67, from the Planning Director, relating to Short-Term Rental Permit caps on Maui and Lāna'i.
- 2. Correspondence from the Committee Chair, dated June 25, 2021, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SHORT-TERM RENTAL HOME PERMITS ON MAUI AND LANA'I." The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish new amounts of Short-Term Rental Home permits allowable on Maui and Lāna'i.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without further revisions. Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication 21-67 and other related action.

#### CONNECTIVITY
