### **NĀ WAI ‘EHĀ STREAMS (APT-1(3))**

**Description:** In accordance with Rule 7(B) of the Rules of the Council, the Committee may receive a presentation and discuss matters relating to Nā Wai ‘Ehā streams.

**Status:** The Committee may receive a presentation from Isaac Moriwake, Managing Attorney of Earthjustice Hawai‘i; and discuss matters relating to the Nā Wai ‘Ehā Decision and Order as it pertains to water usage, including for cultural use. No legislative action will be taken.

### **WATER USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR MAUI (APT-57)**

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 19-162, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN UPDATE TO THE WATER USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE ISLAND OF MAUI.” Attached to the proposed bill is a document entitled “Maui Island Water Use and Development Plan DRAFT, MARCH 2019.” The purpose of the proposed bill is to adopt the attached document as an update to the Maui County Water Use and Development Plan, in accordance

with Sections 14.02.020 and 14.02.040, Maui County Code.

2. Correspondence dated August 13, 2020, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a draft update to the Water Use and Development Plan for Maui Island and Addendum. The purpose of the revised draft and addendum is to provide necessary updates on relevant developments or decisions that have occurred since the plan was submitted on August 10, 2018, including revisions discussed at the Water, Infrastructure, and Transportation Committee meetings on July 13, 2020 and August 4, 2020.
3. Correspondence dated July 14, 2021, from the Committee Chair, transmitting the following sections of the draft update to the Water Use and Development Plan for Maui and Addendum:
  - a. Projected water demand, available resources, and planned growth in the Wailuku Aquifer Sector Area and MDWS Central Maui System Service Area listed in Tables 14-29, 14-30, 14-34, 14-35, and ES.4;
  - b. A summary of recommended strategies for the Wailuku Aquifer Sector Area in Table 14-41; and
  - c. Conservation background, statistics, and strategies for the Wailuku Aquifer Sector Area in Section 14.8.2.

**Status:** The Committee may discuss the Maui Island Water Use and Development Plan draft, with additional focus on the Wailuku aquifer sector area and other related matters. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions; the filing of County Communication 19-162; and other related action.
