COMPREHENSIVE AFFORDABLE HOUSING PLAN (CONTRACT C7183; HAWAIIAN COMMUNITY ASSETS, INC.) (AH-14)

<u>Description:</u> The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Miscellaneous Communication dated January 19, 2021, from the County Clerk, reporting that on January 15, 2021, the Council referred Contract C7183 for a comprehensive affordable housing plan. The contract in the amount of \$300,000 was awarded to Hawaiian Community Assets, Inc. under RFP 21-001OCS, with the final report due by June 30, 2021. Hawaiian Community Assets, Inc. is a nonprofit organization founded in 2000 to increase the capacity of low- and moderate-income communities to achieve economic self-sufficiency, primarily through financial education, counseling, and assets building.
- Correspondence dated July 1, 2021, from Hawaiian Community Assets, Inc., transmitting their final report entitled "Maui County Comprehensive Affordable Housing Plan." The plan is intended to provide a roadmap for the County to meet the housing demands of its residents, focusing on households at or below 120 percent area

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median income.
