PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION NAMING AND RENAMING (IT-73)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- County Communication 21-456, from Councilmember Yuki Lei K. Sugimura, relating to Public Works Commission Naming and Renaming.
- 2. Correspondence dated September 17, 2021, from the Director of Public Works, transmitting the following:
 - a. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.40, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO NAMES OF PUBLIC FACILITIES DESIGNATED." The purposes of the proposed bill are to name:
 - i. as Glenn H. Otani Baseball Field the baseball diamond on the upper field at New Kula Ball Park, also known as New Kula Ball Field; and
 - ii. as Glenn H. Otani Scorebooth the scorebooth at Ichiro "Iron" Maehara Baseball Stadium (Wailuku).
 - b. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.40, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO NAMES OF PUBLIC FACILITIES DESIGNATED." The purpose of the proposed bill is to rename the Kula Community Center as the von

3. Infrastructure and Transportation Committee Report 21-104, dated October 22, 2021 recommending passage of "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.40, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO NAME THE GLENN H. OTANI BASEBALL FIELD (KULA) AND THE GLENN H. OTANI SCOREBOOTH (WAILUKU)." At the November 5, 2021 meeting, the Council adopted the recommendation in Committee Report 21-104 and passed Bill 131 (2021) on first reading.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill to rename the Kula Community Center as the von Tempsky Community Center Complex on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend the filing of County Communication 21-456 and other related action.
