**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

Molina, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "URGING THE MAYOR TO ADDRESS BICYCLE TOUR PUBLIC SAFETY AND RELATED LITIGATION CONCERNS." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to urge the Mayor to address bicycle-tour public safety and related litigation concerns on Maui Island.
