## **WELLHEAD PROTECTION OVERLAY DISTRICT (APT-16)**

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication 15-50, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a draft bill to protect the County's municipal wells from contamination and avoid costly treatment through the restriction of high risk uses in the capture zones of Department of Water Supply drinking water wells.
2. Correspondence dated January 4, 2019, from the Acting Planning Director, providing comments from the Maui, Molokai, and Lānaʻi Planning Commissions on the proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 19, MAUI COUNTY CODE, TO ESTABLISH A WELLHEAD PROTECTION OVERLAY DISTRICT," transmitted via Resolution 18-149.

**Status:** The Committee may receive a presentation from the Department of Water Supply on the proposed bill and discuss matters relating to wellhead protection. No legislative action will be taken.
