AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET: DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TRANSPORTATION BASEYARD) (BFED-122)

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Resolution 22-243 entitled "AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF APPROXIMATELY 12.49 ACRES IDENTIFIED AS TAX MAP KEY NO. (2) 3-8-102:001 (POR) SITUATED AT KAHULUI, MAUI, HAWAII, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$17,413,152.00." Resolution 22-243's purpose is to authorize the acquisition of approximately 12.49 acres identified as tax map key (2) 3-8-102:001 (POR) situated at Kahului, Maui, Hawaii, for a baseyard and maintenance facility, for an amount not to exceed \$17,413,152.00.

Area. Government by adding Lapsed Bond Fund and a project entitled Facilities. "Transportation Baseyard" in the amount of \$10,000,000; and 4) adjusting the totals accordingly.
