RELATING TO AUTHORIZING BILL 118 (2022), THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH U.S. **GEOLOGICAL** SURVEY. **PACIFIC ISLANDS** WATER **SCIENCE** CENTER. UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR (COOPERATIVE WATER-RESOURCE MONITORING PROGRAM) (GREAT-60)

**Description:** The Committee is in receipt of Bill 118 (2022), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, **PACIFIC ISLANDS** WATER **SCIENCE** OF CENTER, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT THE **INTERIOR** (COOPERATIVE WATER-RESOURCE MONITORING PROGRAM)." 118's purpose is to authorize the Mayor to enter into a Joint-Funding Agreement with the United States Geological Survey, Pacific Islands Water Science Center, United States Department of the Interior (USGS) for the Department of Water Supply to continue its cooperative water-resource monitoring program. The Agreement period is from October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2023, and the total cost of the Agreement is \$174,584, of which \$139,153 would be contributed by the County and \$35,431 would be contributed by the USGS.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 118 (2022) on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of Bill 118 (2022) and other related action.

**<u>Description:</u>** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Resolution 22-87, entitled "AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF CLAIM NO. 4063291 OF LORI DONALDSON." Resolution 22-87's purpose is to authorize settlement of the claim filed on January 7, 2020.
- 2. Correspondence dated April 4, 2022, from the County Clerk, with a letter from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, dated March 17, 2022, transmitting a copy of the claim. The claim alleges personal injury damages sustained on November 11, 2019, at Wailea Beach Park, when she was ejected from her wheelchair when it abruptly stopped at the bottom of a wheelchair ramp.
