SUBJECT: LOWER PAIA PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS

The following is in response to your letter dated November 19, 2020, regarding the request for information on the Lower Paia Parking Lot Improvements:

1. Provide an updated status on the design, permitting and construction of the Parking Lot.

The project's design has been completed and the permitting process is in progress. The project is intended to bid in the Spring of 2021 with construction to commence once a contract is executed.

2. You note the improvements will include 55 stalls; accordingly can you clarify if the improvements will account for additional parking beyond the current level of parking in the unimproved parking area?

While it is indeterminate whether the improvements will increase parking, it will definitely organize parking and provide a safer environment with accessible parking and accessible routes to the restroom facility and the bike path, which is frequented by persons in wheel chairs and using the mobility aids (walkers).

3. If additional parking will be created, please identify how many additional stalls will be provided as a result of the improvements?

As noted, the unimproved lot will create 55 parking stalls as well as the required ADA access.

4. Is there property adjacent to the proposed Parking Lot that can be used to expand the parking lot beyond the proposed improvements?

A portion of the adjacent property is being requested by the Paia Youth Council, Inc. for the expansion of their current leased area and construction of a new facility which will include a new parking lot adequate for their program needs.

5. Is it possible to expedite the design, permits and construction of the proposed Parking Lot?

The Department and project consultant are working to expedite all project activities within our control. We will continue to follow up with all reviewing agencies to ensure the project moves forward in a timely manner.

6. Since parking along the North Shore Greenway Bike Path has been restricted, is it possible to create additional parking, on an interim basis, near the Paia Youth Center for beach goers and surfing enthusiasts?

The Department will be reviewing this request to determine the necessary improvements and safety measures required for interim parking in the proposed area.
