WHEREAS, Akiona and his tag team partner Alex Sanchez perform under the group name "Dreamerz," and together qualified out of 100 contestants to enter the 2020 World Beatbox Championships in Berlin, Germany, which were postponed due to the pandemic until 2021; and

WHEREAS, as a solo beatboxer Pono placed in the Top 8 in the Online World Beatbox Championship 2021, making it to the quarterfinal after battling Alex Sanchez, better known as "BizKit," in the Top 16 round; and

WHEREAS, Akiona has been beatboxing for over six years, and his continued commitment to promoting this vocal art has led him to organize the 2021 Hawaii Beatboxing Championship in Kihei, Maui featuring competitors from Maui, Oʻahu and Hawaiʻi Island; and

WHEREAS, 19-year-old Akiona is the son of David and Cheryl Akiona of Wailuku and a graduate of H.P. Baldwin High School; and

WHEREAS, Akiona currently studies business administration at University of Hawaii-Maui College; now, therefore,
