Alex Loria and I have contacted John at All Court Hawaii regarding possible resurfacing (repainting) the two upper courts at War Memorial and painting of lines for 4 - 6 pickleball courts.

John said that with your permission, he would be happy to provide an estimate for this project. Again, players would provide their own portable pickleball nets, so this estimate would not include the installation of permanent nets. This is with the understanding that this could be a temporary and cost effective solution to accommodate the explosive number of pickleball players. In Central Maui, which is the most underserved area in Maui. I believe that you are considering other options for permanent pickleball courts in Wailuku or Kahului, but I think that will not be until 2024 or later.
