Aloha Karla Peters,

Alex Loria and I have contacted John at All Court Hawaii regarding possible resurfacing (repainting) the two upper courts at War Memorial and painting of lines for 4 - 6 pickleball courts.

John said that with your permission, he would be happy to provide an estimate for this project. . Again, players would provide their own portable pickleball nets, so this estimate would not include the installation of permanent nets. . This is with the understanding that this could be a temporary and cost effective solution to accommodate the explosive number of pickleball players in Central Maui, which is the most underserved area in Maui. . I believe that you are considering other options for permanent pickleball courts in Wailuku or Kahului, but I think that will not be until 2024 or later.
