A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19.36B, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate the number of

cars allowed to be parked on a residential property operating as an automobile

rental or car sharing service.

SECTION 2. Section 19.04.040, Maui County Code, is amended by adding

new definitions to be appropriately inserted and to read as follows:

"<u>"Automobile rentals</u>" means car sharing facilities with an office or administrative services.

<u>"Car sharing" is a form of vehicle rental whereby users rent a</u> <u>car for short periods of time. The owners of the cars may be a</u> <u>company, an association, or an individual.</u> Offices intended to <u>attract or register customers are not permitted as an accessory use</u> <u>to car sharing.</u>"

SECTION 3. Section 19.36B.010, Maui County Code, is amended to read

as follows:

"19.36B.010 Purpose and intent. The intent of this chapter is to ensure that onsite, off-street parking spaces, parking surfaces, and maneuvering areas are provided in sufficient quantities for each type of land use <u>and to provide regulations and guidance regarding</u> <u>off-street parking and loading</u> while maximizing safety and minimizing impacts on adjacent properties and the environment."

SECTION 4. Chapter 19.36B, Maui County Code, is amended by adding

a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"<u>19.36B.130</u> Parking on residential properties. No more than two vehicles associated with an automobile rental or car sharing service that is operating on a residential property may be stored or parked outside a structure on the property."

SECTION 5. New material is underscored. In printing this ordinance, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
