



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.60, MAUI COUNTY  
CODE, RELATING TO A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR BOARD,  
COMMISSION, AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2.60, Maui County Code, is amended by adding a  
new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

**“2.60.040 Residency requirements for board,  
commission, and committee members. Only County residents  
are eligible for appointment to a board, commission, or committee,  
unless the council waives the residency requirement by a resolution  
adopted by a two-thirds vote. If a member of a board, commission,  
or committee ceases to be a resident of the County, the member  
must notify the mayor and council chair within ten days of their  
residency change. Residency outside of the County or failure to  
report a residency change outside of the County as required by this  
section is cause for removal. For this section, “resident” means a  
person who meets the requirements of a home exemption claim  
under section 3.48.450 other than the requirement to own and  
occupy real property as a principal home. ”**

SECTION 2. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
