Dear Councilmember Crivello:

I've received your letter dated 10/24/17 regarding the parcel of land that the County of Maui leases to UH Maui College. This parcel was formerly used for student housing. Your letter included two inquiries:

1. Is the University of Hawai'i Maui College (UHMC) willing to remain on the lease if the existing structures need to be demolished?

If the County of Maui decides against canceling the lease, UHMC is willing to continue the lease.

2. If so, what is UHMC's intent with the parcel thereafter?

UHMC will soon begin updating its Long Range Development Plan (LRDP). We would determine how best to integrate use of the County of Maui parcel with the college campus during this planning process. If the College is allowed to retain the lease of the property, the College would demolish the old dormitory structures, while the College LRDP is in process.
