SUBJECT: BICYCLE-TOUR PUBLIC SAFETY AND RELATED LITIGATION CONCERNS (GREAT-44)

Dear Chair Molina:

This transmission is in response to your letter dated November 9, 2021, requesting comments on the proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.22, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO BICYCLE TOUR BUSINESSES". Below are the Department of Finance's comments and/or recommendations:

- 1. Section 5.22.010: Amend the definition of "Application" to read, "Application" means a form provided by the department that must be submitted to initiate a new permit request, amendment or renewal of an unexpired permit."
- 2. Section 5.22.010: Modify the definition of "Bicycle" to conform with the definition in HRS Section 249-1: "Bicycle" means: (1) A device propelled solely by human power upon which any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixteen inches in diameter or greater, and including any device generally recognized as a bicycle though equipped with two front or two rear wheels; or (2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title 15 United States Code section 2085.

- 3. Section 5.22.025 (B): Provide further clarity (guidelines) on the allocation methodology of the six maximum allowed tours in each of the two community plan areas. Who will implement and monitor?
- 4. Section 5.22.020 (D): Amend to include check of issued citations:

... Within twenty [working] business days from the receipt thereof, the department of police [shall] must <u>indicate whether the applicant has received any citations within the past year and submit to the director\_a written report with any recommendations or special conditions [which] that may be necessary or desirable.</u>
