PROPOSAL FOR COMMERCIAL BIKE TOURS OPERATING IN UPCOUNTRY MAUI

- 1. All commercial bike tour companies must obtain a Maui County Bike Tour Permit and carry the required liability insurance per the permit
- 2. Commercial bike tour companies may conduct guided and self-guided tours in the Kula, Pukalani, Makawao, Pa'ia, and Ha'iku communities only during the hours of 8:00 am 1:30 pm, thereby avoiding the peak school traffic hours
- 3. Commercial bike tours may not operate on Sundays in the Kula, Pukalani, Makawao, Pa'ia, and Ha'iku communities
- 4. Commercial bike tours may not operate in the Kula, Pukalani, Makawao, Pa'ia, and Ha'iku communities on selected Hawaiian Cultural Days. These days include the Start of Makahiki, the End of Makahiki, The Zenith Noon, Summer Solstice, and Winter Solstice
- 5. Guided bike tours will be limited to no more than (12) guests per group while riding and have an employee cruise leader on a bike at the front of the group and an employee driven escort vehicle following the group
