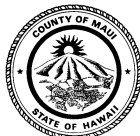

APPOINTMENT OF CHARLEEN “NAOMI” CROZIER TO THE COMMISSION ON HEALING SOLUTIONS FOR HOMELESSNESS

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 5117 (2020), the Commission on Healing Solutions for Homelessness was established to protect and promote public health, safety, and welfare of residents and maintain the commitment of aloha ‘āina; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 5117 also provides that the Commission, as an advisory group, will provide recommendations to the Council and the administration on funding and policies to help combat and eliminate homelessness and poverty in Maui County; and

WHEREAS, under Chapter 2.31, Maui County Code, the Commission on Healing Solutions for Homelessness, consists of 11 members, where nine members are appointed by the Council by resolution, and two members are appointed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, each member of the Commission may serve for staggered terms of three years, and those appointed by the Council must demonstrate expertise relevant to the Commission to one of the nine Council residency areas; and

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated June 1, 2022, Wendy Hudson resigned as a member of the Commission on Healing Solutions for Homelessness, effective June 24, 2022, creating a vacancy in a seat for a term expiring March 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated July 25, 2022, Government, Ethics, and Transparency (“GREAT”) Committee Chair Molina transmitted to the GREAT Committee Charleen “Naomi” Crozier’s application to the Commission on Healing Solutions for Homelessness, dated July 19, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Crozier is a board member of the Hawai‘i State Council of Mental Health, which monitors the provision of mental-health services; and



WHEREAS, Ms. Crozier works for Mental Health Kokua, where she has spent the past 12 years helping people without shelter obtain case management; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it approves the appointment of Charleen “Naomi” Crozier to the Committee on Healing Solutions for Homelessness for a term expiring March 31, 2024, to fill a vacancy due to the resignation of Wendy Hudson;
2. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Charleen “Naomi” Crozier for her willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
3. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Housing and Human Concerns, Mayor, Managing Director, Corporation Counsel, and Charleen “Naomi” Crozier.
