CONGRATULATING MAUI COUNTY WINNERS AT THE 2022 ISLAND MOVERS/HAWAII HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION STATE TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

WHEREAS, student-athletes representing three Maui County high schools captured four State championships at the 2022 Island Movers/Hawaii High School Athletic Association State Track and Field Championships on May 13 and 14 at Kunuiakea Stadium on the campus of Kamehameha Schools Kapālama in Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, these Maui County student-athletes continued the Maui Interscholastic League's tradition of producing notable performances at the State track and field championships; and

WHEREAS, Maui High School senior Kaimana Cantere in an exciting come-from-behind win captured the championship in the 800-meter run, with a time of 1 minute, 59.92 seconds and in doing so became the first Maui High School runner in its history to best two minutes in the event; and

WHEREAS, Baldwin High School senior Justin Kahalewai won the 110-meter hurdles with a personal best time of 15.59 seconds; and

WHEREAS, H.P. Baldwin High School junior Joseph Randolph finished first in the 100-meter dash, with a winning time of 10.97 seconds, and in doing so earned the unofficial title of fastest in the state; and

WHEREAS, Seabury Hall senior Kaylee Volner captured the championship in the 3000-meter run with a personal-best time of 10 minutes, 17.93 seconds; and

WHEREAS, Kaylee Volner was honored as The Maui News' Girls Track and Field Athlete of the year, and Kaimana Cantere was honored as the Maui News' Boys Track and Field Athlete of the Year; and

WHEREAS, with the support and guidance of their dedicated head coaches—Belden Bautista of Maui High School, Derick Dahilig of Baldwin

High School, and Bobby Grossman of Seabury Hall—student-athletes Kaimana Cantere, Justin Kahalewai, Joseph Randolph, and Kaylee Volner maintained academic success, displayed extraordinary sportsmanship, and achieved excellence in the sport of track and field; and

WHEREAS, the exceptional performances, dedication, and spirit of these outstanding student-athletes brings great pride and honor to their 'ohana, their schools, the community, and the County of Maui; now, therefore,
